The Names of God - Part 1

- 1. Why Study the Names of God?
- 2. "Elohim"
 - A) Meaning/Definition
 - The Supreme One, the Mighty One.
 - Plural form of "El" which means First/Stronge
 One. "El" is often not seen alone but is usually
 at the beginning of another name of God
 (El Shaddai or El Elyon).
 - Genesis 1:1- God alone is eternal-God alone is infinite.
 - God is not like us.
 - God exists outside of time, space, and matter.
 - God created "ex nihilo" He created something out of nothing. Hebrews 11:3
 - In chapter 1 of Genesis, it is "Elohim" that is used for God's name.
 - What Elohim does it is good.
 - "God took chaos and formed something good, and He can do that with our lives." Tony Evans
 - B) Elohim is in the plural: 2 schools of thought:
 - Highlights the triune God
 - Highlights and communicates that God encompasses all His attributes.

- C) Our Relation to Elohim
 - He is our Maker- Genesis 1:27
 - Psalm 139: 13-16

"You knitted me together in my mother's womb. 14 I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. 15 My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately woven in the depths of the earth. 16 Your eyes saw my unformed substance; in your book were written, every one of them, the days that were formed for me, when as yet there was none of them."
