

The Names of God - Part 5 "Jehovah Shalom" "Jehovah Rapha"

JEHOVAH SHALOM - "The Lord of Peace"

- Shalom is seen as complete in the sense of whole. It is used as a greeting in Israel today as well as a blessing when you depart.
- 1. Jehovah Shalom is first seen in the Bible in Judges 6:24, "Then Gideon built an altar there to the LORD and called it, The LORD Is Peace."
- 2. Shalom is seen as a wholeness in one's relationship with God.
 - 1 Chronicles 29:19, "Grant to Solomon my son a whole heart (Shalom) that he may keep your commandments, your testimonies, and your statutes, performing all, and that he may build the palace for which I have made provision."
- 3. The significance of Jehovah Shalom and Jesus Isaiah 9:6-7, "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace (Shalom). Of the increase of his government and of peace (Shalom) there will be no end, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from

this time forth and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this."

Colossians 1:19, "And through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross."

JEHOVAH RAPHA - "The Lord Heals/Restores" or Jehovah, He is the One who Heals.

- 1. Jehovah Rapha occurs 60 times in the Old Testament.
- 2. Jehovah Rapha means that God not only heals the body, but also the mind and the soul.
- **3.** God is the one who is turned to for healing. Exodus 15:26, "If you will diligently listen to the voice of the LORD your God, and do that which is right in his eyes, and give ear to his commandments and keep all his statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you that I put on the Egyptians, for I am the LORD, your healer."
- **4.** God is the object of the healing. Psalm 6:2, "Be gracious to me, O LORD, for I am languishing; heal (Rapha) me, O LORD, for my bones are troubled."
