

# DOCTRINE OF GRACE

Mercy: Mercy is God not punishing us as our sins deserve- deliverance from judgment.

**Grace:** Grace is God blessing us even though we do not deserve it- extending kindness to the unworthy. Grace is totally divine- it excludes human merit.

## 1. God's Grace to all- Common Grace

#### Hebrews 1:3

"He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high."

# 2. God's Grace is demonstrated in salvation.

Ephesians 2:8-9

"For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast."

"Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need."

### 4. God's Grace means that we are no longer bound by the law.

#### Romans 6:14

"For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace."

### 5. God's Grace sustains us.


#### Psalm 119:116
