Wednesday Night PRAYER SERVICE DOCTRINE OF SECURITY

1. Salvation is the sole work of God.

Ephesians 2:4-9

2. The purpose of God.

Ephesians 1:4 "Even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love."

3. The power of God to save.

John 10:28-30 "I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand. I and the Father are one."

4. The Love of God.

Romans 5:6-9 "For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Since, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God."

5. The assurance of God.

Romans 8:31-34

6. The promise of being in Christ.

Romans 8:1 "There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."

7. The advocacy of Christ

1 John 2:1 "My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous."

8. The guarantee from Scripture.

1 John 5:13 "I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life."
